AN ORDINANCE TO RAISE FUNDS AND SUPPLIES FOR THE YEAR COMMENCING
JULY 1, 1986 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1987, AND TO PROVIDE FOR
ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION FOR ALL TAXES COVERING SAID PERIOD.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of
Ridgeway in meeting duly assembled:

SECTION 1 That for the purpose of raising supplies and funds
for general purposes and to meet the general
obligations as the Town of Ridgeway for the year
commencing July 1, 1986 and ending June 30, 1987
a tax of 74 mils ad valorem is hereby levied and
assessed upon every dollar of the value of all real
and personal property within the corporate limits
of the said Town.

SECTION 2 All taxes and sums assessed and payable under the
provisions of this ordinance shall be paid in legal
currency and tender of the United States of America.

SECTION 3 All taxes and sums herein assessed and provided for
shall be due and payable between September 1, 1986
and January 15, 1987, and all such taxes and sums
remaining due and unpaid at the close of business
of the 15th day of January, 1987, shall be subject
to a penalty of fifteen (15%) percent and all such
taxes and sums, including penalty, which remain due
and unpaid at the close of business on March 15,
1987 shall be subject to an additional penalty on
the whole sum, both tax and previous penalty, of
five (5%) percent and shall be collected by distress
or otherwise, as is provided by law, together with
all legal costs and legal penalties.

SECTION 4 In the event any portion of this ordinance is
declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining
portion shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 1 - THAT a special election be held to determine if the Town of Ridgeway, S. C. shall change its form of government from the Mayor Council form to the Council form, such special election to be held in the manner provided by the laws and statutes of the State of South Carolina.

AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE AN ELECTION TO DETERMINE IF THE TOWN OF RIDGEWAY, S.C. SHALL CHANGE ITS FORM OF GOVERNMENT FROM THE MAYOR-COUNCIL FORM TO THE COUNCIL FORM

BE IT ORDAINED by the Ridgeway Town Council:

- Section 1 That a special election be held to determine if the Town of Ridgeway, S.C. shall change its form of government from the Mayor-Council form to Council form.
- Section 2 No Town funds shall be expended for attorney opinions in this matter.
- Section 3 The special election mentioned above shall be held as soon as possible but not earlier than 30 days from the passage of this ordinance and no later than 90 days from passage of this ordinance. There must be a published three week notice of the election.
- Section 4 The Town of Ridgeway shall pay all expenses incurred in the conduct of any election.
- Section 5 The Ridgeway Election Commission is hereby required to conduct said election pursuant to this ordinance.
